Art Vertlieb, QC is the current president of the Law Society of British Columbia and has been a Bencher since 2004 during which time he has served on many committees and played a significant role in formulating the Law Society's approach to access to justice issues. He is a partner at Vertlieb Dosanjh Trial Lawyers in Vancouver where he is focused on personal injury law, medical negligence, professional disputes and criminal law.

Vertlieb has an extensive history of involvement in the legal profession. He is a past governor of the American Association for Justice, an elected fellow of the International Academy of Trial Lawyers and a member of the Yukon Law Society Discipline Committee. He is a former president and founding vice-president of the Trial Lawyers Association of BC and a former chair and founding member of the Lawyers Assistance Program of BC. He also served for five years as a member of the Judicial Council of British Columbia.

Vertlieb is a recipient of several awards, including the Queen's Diamond Jubilee medal.
