Please note that **effective July 1, 2007, ALL RECORDS ON MOTION OR APPLICATION** as well as **ALL BRIEFS** will be required to be filed with the Clerk's Office within the time frame specified by the *Rules of Court*, in both trial and family divisions:


- For Records on Application, 24 hours before the hearing, as per Rule 38.06
- For Records on Motion, 48 hours before the hearing as per Rule 39.05
- For Pre-Trial Conference Briefs and Pre-Trial Briefs, 4 days before the settlement conference or trial, as per Rules 50.12 and 47.11

If the Record or Brief is not filed within the time frame specified by the *Rules*, it will be returned to you without being filed and your matter will be **WITHDRAWN FROM THE DOCKET WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE**.

You will then be required to re-file your documents to obtain a new date for the hearing.

Please note there will be **no exceptions**.
