I am writing on behalf of the Canadian Bar Association's Construction and Infrastructure Law Section (CBA Section) to extend our congratulations on your recent election and appointment as Minister of Infrastructure and Communities. We look forward to establishing a positive and constructive relationship with you and your team.

The CBA is a national association representing over 36,000 jurists, including lawyers, notaries, law teachers, and students across Canada. We promote the rule of law, access to justice, effective law reform and provide expertise on how the law touches the lives of Canadians every day. The CBA Section examines the law and practice relating to the construction industry, including contracts, bonding, insurance, arbitration and litigation.

We are pleased to see that your mandate includes creating a National Infrastructure Fund to seek out and support major nation-building projects. The <u>2019 Canadian Infrastructure Report Card</u> comments on the state of Canada's public infrastructure such as roads, bridges, potable water and public transit. The report finds that our infrastructure is at risk and will require significant attention in the coming decades.
