Yukon Wildlife Preserve Tour • Go wild! Join us for a fantastic Yukon safari where you will explore a wildlife preserve in a natural habitat and of course is home to many amazing northern critters! This outing starts at your hotel with a local tour guide greeting you at your hotel and driving you to the northern edge of Whitehorse about 25 minutes out. This is a great time to sit back as you head out of the downtown and see more of Whitehorse area as you make your way to the Yukon Wildlife Preserve. Of course, along the way you get insightful information and maybe a story or two from your guide about the area and why Whitehorse makes a great place to work, live and of course play. This preserve is located in over 750 acres with 13 different northern species of animals. The landscape and park is very natural for the animals to roam in their habitat area. There are no predators such as bears or wolves in order to keep the other animals safe and healthy. This is a great educational tour offering of wildlife in a respectful safe environment.

Explore and enjoy..... We recognize guests have different interest levels and needs that is why you will have two tour options to choose from.

#1 The Guided Explorer - Hop on a small comfortable bus and the knowledgeable guide will provide you with a full on interpretive 90 minute tour. Of course, when the bus stops there will be time to get on and off to enjoy commentary and snap a picture or two and continue around the park. This is an excellent tour option for those folks who want to learn more about our animals and relax at the same time.

#2 The Independent Explorer – Lace up your shoesgo adventure on your own with a preserve map they provide to you and get a good workout walk. While appreciating the fresh air, quietness and beauty of the distinctive habitat where you will be able to safely safari independently with a map and can learn about the animals at your own pace with informative place cards along the 3.1 mile (5 kilometer) gravel mixed terrain route.

Please bring a jacket, comfortable sturdy footwear (no flip flops or open toe, water, camera if walking a small day pack

Your local guide will pick you up at the hotel and will provide a great interpretive chat while you enjoy a scenic relaxing drive in a photographer's paradise of diverse landscapes with plenty of stops along the way to take in the incredible views and breathing the healthy fresh outdoor air including Yukon mountain countryside landscapes, Yukon's most photographed brilliant green Emerald Lake, historic First Nation cultural village of Carcross which was a significant transportation hub during the Gold Rush where we will stretch our legs and have a chance to lightly explore, snack and beverage break on the shores of historic Lake Bennett, learn about the amazing White Pass Railway, stop at the World's smallest desert & make our way to the BC/Yukon border and of course on the way back take the scenic route back to the downtown with a stop at the ever popular Miles Canyon to fill your senses.....

This is our most popular tour a lot of area and information are covered all in half a day as you get to learn about local history with an incredible backdrop of scenery with the majestic coastal mountain ranges and the vast southern lake river systems.
